Smart, Water-Wise Landscape Design for Colorado Living

ColoradoScaping is FRSR's signature approach to landscape design in the Colorado Front Range. It reflects a deep understanding of regional climate, water availability, soil conditions, and how outdoor spaces are actually used throughout the year.

Rather than relying on high-water plantings or short-lived trends, ColoradoScaping emphasizes thoughtful layouts, drought-tolerant plant selections, decorative rock and mulch systems, efficient irrigation, and integrated hardscape elements. Each landscape is designed to balance performance, appearance, and long-term sustainability.

This approach allows us to create outdoor environments that feel natural, intentional, and refined—while reducing water use, maintenance demands, and long-term costs. The result is a landscape that works with Colorado's conditions instead of against them.

STAMPED CONCRETE PATTERNS

A curated selection of stamped concrete patterns installed by FRSR

At FRSR, we focus on stamped concrete patterns that perform well in Colorado's climate and complement outdoor living spaces over time. Rather than offering endless options, we curate a focused selection of patterns based on real installations, long-term durability, and visual balance.

Each pattern shown here has been installed across projects throughout the Front Range and is chosen for how it integrates with architecture, landscape design, and outdoor use.



Large Ashlar Slate

A large-format stone pattern designed for expansive patios and outdoor living spaces, offering clean geometry and natural texture.



Medium Ashlar Slate

A balanced ashlar layout with slightly smaller stone scale, well-suited for patios, walkways, and transitional areas.



Yorkstone

A classic rectangular stone pattern with strong lines and a traditional European feel.



Barn Wood Plank

A realistic wood-grain texture that delivers the warmth of wood with the durability of concrete.



London Cobble

A rounded cobblestone pattern that adds character and visual depth to patios, walkways, and borders.



Colorado Flagstone

A natural flagstone look inspired by Colorado landscapes, offering organic shapes and regional character.



Random Mesa Stone

Irregular stone shapes with natural variation, creating a relaxed and organic surface appearance.



Castlestone

A bold, dimensional stone pattern that creates depth and texture for larger outdoor areas.



Random Stone

A versatile stone pattern with varied shapes that blends naturally into both modern and traditional designs.



Rough Stone Texture

A heavier stone texture designed to add depth and a more rustic surface appearance.



Italian Slate Texture

A refined slate texture with subtle variation and a clean, timeless look.



Blue Stone Texture

A tight, consistent slate texture inspired by natural bluestone surfaces.



Belgium Slate Texture

A classic slate texture with soft movement and understated surface detail.



Roman Slate Texture

A smooth slate texture with minimal grout lines, offering a clean and cohesive stone appearance.

STAMPED CONCRETE & OVERLAYS

Decorative Concrete Designed for Long-Term Performance.

Stamped concrete is more than a surface treatment — it is a structural system that requires careful planning, proper preparation, and long-term consideration. At FRSR, stamped concrete is designed and installed with durability, performance, and longevity in mind.

Before any concrete is placed, we evaluate layout, grading, drainage, reinforcement, expansion, and finish selection. These early decisions ensure surfaces that integrate naturally with the surrounding landscape while performing reliably through Colorado's seasonal temperature swings.

Concrete overlays provide an opportunity to enhance or refresh existing surfaces without full replacement when conditions allow. When properly designed and installed, overlays can extend the life of a space while improving appearance, texture, and usability.

By approaching concrete as a long-term structural element rather than a decorative finish, we create outdoor surfaces that age gracefully, maintain integrity, and support the overall design of the outdoor environment.



ARTIFICIAL TURF SYSTEMS

Water-Wise, Durable, and Built to Perform.



Artificial turf is most effective when it is designed and installed as a complete system, not treated as a standalone product. At FRSR, turf is integrated into the broader landscape to support water efficiency, durability, drainage, and long-term performance.

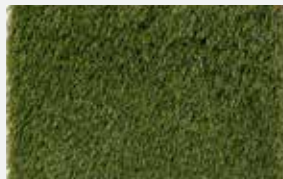
Our turf installations are engineered with proper base preparation, compaction, edging, and drainage to ensure stability and consistent appearance over time. This system-based approach prevents shifting, pooling, and premature wear while creating clean, usable outdoor spaces. Artificial turf aligns naturally with ColoradoScaping principles by significantly reducing water use while maintaining year-round usability. When thoughtfully selected and installed, turf becomes a practical surface solution that integrates seamlessly with hardscapes, plantings, and outdoor living areas.



Ultimate Natural Tall

A premium, natural-looking turf with taller blade height designed to closely replicate real grass. Ideal for residential landscapes and outdoor living areas requiring a lush appearance.

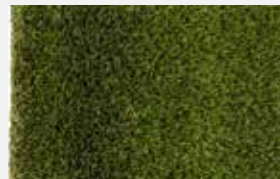

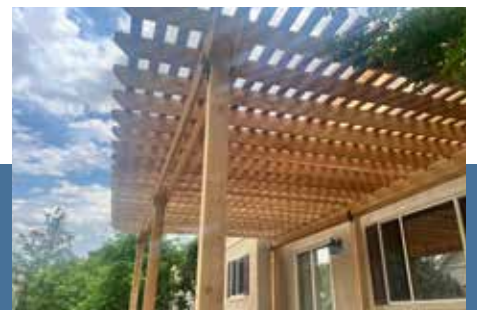
Bringing Design, Structure, and Function Together.
